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### 1. WRAPPED IN RIBBON.

A finely etched band adorns each fluted cup in Vera Wang's "Grosgrain" stemware pattern for Wedgwood. The design is available on a goblet (not shown), white-wine glass, Champagne flute, or red-wine glass (\$25 per stem; 800-955-1550 for stores).

### 2. HOP TO IT.

Wee ones will be cleaning their plates to see what little Lola Bunny is up to. These sturdy porcelain pieces by Yves Deshoulières are packaged in a red valise, which will quickly find a second life as a toy tote (\$85 for the four-piece set; from Zebra Hall, 800-834-9165).
